<u>SUBJECT:</u> Introduction of Agency Shop in the Public Service.

Cabinet has agreed to accord Agency Shop facilities to the Guyana Public Service Union and to affiliates of the Federation of Unions of Government Employees.

- 2. In order to give effect to this decision you are asked to include as a condition of their employment and continuing employment in the Public Service the payment of Agency fees by the check-off system, in the terms and conditions of employment of new entrants into the Public Service as from the 15! March, 1976 unless he/she chooses to become a member of the Union. The Agency fees to be deducted from salaries/wages will be equivalent to the dues charged by the appropriate Union.
- 3. It is intended that the Agency Shop facilities should apply only in respect of the occupations and/or classifications traditionally represented by individual Unions. Attached hereto are details in this regard.
- 4. This Ministry will be holding meetings with the Guyana Public Service Union and the Federation of Unions of Government Employees with the view to arriving at formal agreements on the further application of Agency Shop facilities including the determination of the use to which such fees should be applied and the extent of service to be rendered or made available to an employee paying Agency fees. However, it should be made clear that the introduction of Agency Shop facilities is without prejudice to any future legislation on the subject.
