<u>SUBJECT:</u> Recruitment of Married Women into the Administrative and Clerical Classes of the Public Service.

Pending the enactment of legislation relative to the removal of the bar to permanent employment of married women in the Public Service, approval has been given for the recruitment of married women into the administrative and clerical classes as well as the professional and technical classes of the Public Service.

- 2. Accordingly the conditional administrative approval previously given for female employees who are married to have their services retained is now confirmed.
- 3. A married woman recruited (or retained) in the Public Service shall be subject to the same rules and Conditions of Service as are applicable to any other employee of the same grade on the permanent pensionable or permanent non-pensionable establishment of the Public Service as the case may be.
- 4. Please bring this circular to the attention of all employees in your Ministry/Department.
