TO: All Permanent Secretaries, Heads of Departments and Regional Executive Officers <u>SUBJECT:</u> Release of Staff for work on Aided Self-help Housing Projects.

- My circular 32/1975 provided that employees be given "time-off", with full pay, from their regular employment to enable them to participate in Aided Self-help Housing Projects. A concomitant to such release was that no wages or salaries should be paid to self-helpers absent from the self-help site.
 - 2. It has come to attention that self-helpers are absenting themselves from their work site without permission and that such absences – as recorded in Weekly Reports issued by the site Foreman – are being covered by the grant of annual leave instead of by the deduction of the equivalent in pay from salary/wages. Where this has occurred arrangements should be made to recover the amounts overpaid.
 - 3. It should be noted that arrangements exist for self-helpers to be granted 'time-off from their work site' provided they have reached set targets; reported as "absent without permission".
 - 4. Please bring the contents of this circular to the attention of all employees in your Ministry, Department, Corporation and Company.
