SUBJECT: Amendment to the existing General Certificate of Education 'Ordinary Level' Examination requirements for appointment as Clerk II's in the Public Service.

Kindly refer to my Circular No. 13/1977 dated 8th March, 1977, on the abovementioned subject.

- 2. For the sake of clarification, please be advised that a pass at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" is considered to be one obtained not lower than at the <u>Grade E</u> Level in respect of any subject obtained prior to the June, 1975 examination, whereas for subjects obtained at that examination or subsequent examinations, a pass is considered to be not lower than the Grade C level.
- 3. I shall therefore be grateful if you will ensure that the contents of this circular are brought to the attention of <u>all</u> officers in your Personnel Division/Section and those who deal with the recruitment of clerical staff.
