– Amendment No. 6 – Appendix K 5: Station  
Allowance.**

Appendix K 5 of the Civil Service Rules (1972 and 1976 Editions) is hereby amended as follows:-

(i) By the addition of the following after the word "Dock" in B (ii):-

“and those areas around Bartica, the inhabitants of which have to purchase their rations at Bartica”

(ii) By the deletion of the words “from and including Makouria” after the words “Essequibo River” in C (i) and the substitution therefore of the following:-

“above Makouria, except those areas around Bartica, the inhabitants of which have to purchase their rations at Bartica”.

2. The above amendment takes effect immediately but it has been decided that employees who have been stationed in the areas, over any period during which rates for Bartica have been higher than the rates applicable to the areas, should be paid at the higher rates over the period.
3. Please bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of all employees concerned.
