**SUBJECT: Civil Service Rules 1972 and 1976 Editions
– Amendment No. 9 – Leave Passage Entitlement.**

DATE: 12th July, 1977.

Approval has been given for the rates of leave passage entitlements payable to public servants to be increased with effect from 1st January, 1975 as set out in the following Schedule. Rule H1 of the Civil Service Rules 1972 and 1976 Editions is hereby amended accordingly:-

CATEGORY	LEAVE ENTITLEMENT	PASSAGE ENTITLEMENT
A – Salary over \$10,496 per annum	40 days a year which may be accumulated to a maximum of 4 months and taken after every tour of three (3) years.	After every tour of 3 years assisted passages for the public servant, spouse and children not exceeding a total cost of \$5,200.
B – Salary above \$6,822 up to \$10,496 per annum	35 days a year which may be accumulated to a maximum of 4 months and taken after every tour of 4 years.	After every tour of 4 years assisted passages for the public servant and spouse not exceeding a total cost of \$3,300.
C – Salary above \$5,560 up to \$6,822 per annum	30 days a year which may be accumulated to a maximum of 4 months and taken after every tour of 5 years.	After every tour of 5 years assisted passage for the public servant not exceeding \$1,500.
D- Salary above \$4,410 up to \$5,560 per annum	25 days a year which may be accumulated to a maximum of 3 months and taken after every tour of 5 years.	After every tour of 5 years assisted passage for the public servant not exceeding \$400.
E- Salary under \$4,410 per annum	20 days a year which may be accumulated to a maximum of 2 months and taken after every tour of 6 years.	After every tour of 6 years assisted passage for the public servant not exceeding \$140.
