<u>SUBJECT:</u> Conversion Table for incumbents of positions of Typist Clerk II, Stenographer I and II, Confidential Secretary and Clerk I which were reclassified with effect from January 1, 1977.

With reference to the second paragraph of Section 3 of my Circular No. 49/1977 dated 21<sup>st</sup> October, 1977, I set out below the Conversion Table applicable to the incumbents of positions of Typist Clerk II, Stenographer I and II, Confidential Secretary and Clerk I which were reclassified with effect from January 1, 1977.

- 2. The incremental date for each of the incumbents of the abovementioned reclassified positions will now become <u>January 1</u>.
- 3. In order to eliminate the possibility of differing interpretations in computing the arrears for the employees involved, the following illustrative examples are provided:

## EXAMPLE 1.

A Clerk I on reclassification as Clerk II with effect from January 1, 1977 converted to \$207 a month on that date and proceeded to the salary point \$212 on May 11, 1977. His/her revised monthly salary according to the foregoing table is \$238.44.

Revised salary for period 1 <sup>st</sup> January, 1977 – 31 <sup>st</sup> October, 1977 (10 X \$238.44)	=	\$2384.40

For period 1 <sup>st</sup> January, 1977 – 10 <sup>th</sup> May, 1977 at \$207 p.m.	=	\$894.77		
For period 11 <sup>th</sup> May, 1977 – 31 <sup>st</sup> October, 1977	=	\$1203.61	=	\$2098.38 \$286.02

## EXAMPLE 2

A Confidential Secretary on reclassification from Salary Range A12 to A13 converted to \$330 a month on January 1, 1977 and proceeded to the salary point \$338 on July 2, 1977. Her revised monthly salary according to the foregoing table is \$351.60.

Revised salary for period 1 <sup>st</sup> January, 1977 – 31 <sup>st</sup> October, 1977 (10 X \$351.60)	=	\$3516.00

For period 1 <sup>st</sup> January, 1977 – 1 <sup>st</sup> July, 1977 at \$330 per month	=	\$1990.65	
For period 2 <sup>nd</sup> July, 1977 – 31 <sup>st</sup> October, 1977	=	\$1341.10	\$3331.75 \$184.25
