TO: All Permanent Secretaries, Heads of Departments and Regional Executive Officers <u>SUBJECT:</u> Payment of Revised salaries and Wages to Government Employees.

With reference to my Circular No. 49/1977 dated 21st October, 1977, all Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments are asked to ensure that every possible effort is made by their Accounting Staff to pay the hourly-paid, daily-paid, weekly-paid and fortnightly-paid workers their arrears before the salaries staff.

2. With respect to the Appendices to my Circular No. 49/1977 certain <u>actual</u> converted figures shown therein are less than \$200. However, since it is specifically stated in paragraph 1 of the Circular under reference that the new monthly minimum is \$200., it is clear that no worker will receive a revised salary less than \$200. a month. As such, in cases where the figure reflected in the schedules is less than \$200., the converted point for purposes of computation of arrears is \$200.
