**SUBJECT: Schedule of Acting Allowances effective
from January 1, 1977.**

DATE: 24th October, 1977.

Consequent on the implementation of the new salary rates with effect from January 1, 1977, the following schedule of Acting Allowances takes effect from the same date:-

<u>Acting Appointments falling within the limits of the undermentioned salary ranges</u>	<u>Acting Allowances payable</u>
A4 to A8	The difference between the substantive salary of the employee and the revised minimum of the position in which he/she is required to act; <u>or \$12.00 a month</u> – whichever is the greater.
A9 to A15	The difference between the substantive salary of the employee and the revised minimum of the position in which he/she is required to act; <u>or \$16.00 a month</u> – whichever is the greater.
A16 to A17	The difference between the substantive salary of the employee and the revised minimum (or revised commencing salary) of the position in which he/she is required to act; <u>or \$20.00 a month</u> – whichever is the greater.
A18 to A22	The difference between the substantive salary of the employee and the revised minimum (or revised commencing salary) of the position in which he/she is required to act; <u>or \$28.00 a month</u> – whichever is the greater.
A23 to A26	The difference between the substantive salary of the employee and the revised minimum (or revised commencing salary) of the position in which he/she is required to act; <u>or \$30.00 a month</u> – whichever is the greater.
A27 to A40	The quantum of the acting allowance shall continue to be determined in the same way as it was done prior to January 1, 1977, in accordance with the Civil Service Rules.
