SUBJECT: Turkeyen Third World Lecture Series 1977.

DATE: 18th November, 1977.

Dr. ANTONY VRATUSA who is one of the three Vice-Presidents of the Republic of Yugoslavia, will have the honour of delivering this year's Turkeyen Third World lectures. Set out below are the dates, time, venue, and topics of the lectures.

<u>Date and Time</u>	<u>Venue and Topic</u>
Wednesday November 23, at 7.00 p.m.	Large Lecture Theatre – University of Guyana – Foundations of National Independence and Socialist Development in Yugoslavia.
Thursday November 24, at 7.00 p.m.	Liches Hall, Linden – The Theory and Practice of Socialist Self-Management.
Friday November 25, at 7.00 p.m.	Queen's College, Georgetown – Yugoslavia Policy of Non-Alignment stemming from the system of Self-Management.

The importance of the Turkeyen Lectures has not diminished since the series was inaugurated by President Nyerere during his visit to Guyana in September, 1974.

2. The aim of these Lectures is to provide annual opportunities for eminent personalities of the Third World noted for their contributions through practical action or creative thought, to make still further contributions to the evolving strategy of the Third World in its search for economic justice.
3. Accordingly, you are asked to stress the importance of these lectures to members of your staff and, as far as possible, ensure their attendance.
4. To facilitate the attendance of members of your staff who do not have their own transportation, you are requested to make available as many vehicles as possible that are under your control, as well as the services of the drivers.
5. Your usual co-operation in these matters will be appreciated.
