Revised rates of travelling allowances – Amendment to Appendix J1 to the Civil Service Rules 1976, Amendment No. 1/79

DATE: 3rd August, 1979.

Approval has been given for the rates of travelling allowances payable to public officers who are authorized to use motor-cars, motor-cycles, auto-cycles and bicycles on official duties to be increased with effect from 1st January, 1979 inclusive as set out hereunder:-

I – MOTOR-CAR ALLOWANCES

(a) Scale 'A' Rates

(i) To public servants holding posts requiring the use of cars 1400cc and over:-

A fixed allowance of \$248.00 per month with a mileage allowance of 32 cents per mile.

(ii) To public servants holding posts requiring the use of cars under 1400cc:-

A fixed allowance of \$211.00 per month with a mileage allowance of 28 cents per mile.

(b) Scale 'B' Rate

An allowance of \$82 cents per mile regardless of engine capacity.

(c) Scale 'C' Rate

A commuted allowance of \$164.00 per month which inclusive of all travelling done in the Greater Georgetown area (or New Amsterdam if the officer is based there), with a mileage allowance of 82 cents per mile for travel outside Greater Georgetown or New Amsterdam.

II - MOTOR-CYCLE ALLOWANCES

(i) To public servants holding posts requiring the use of motor-cycles 250cc and over:-

A fixed allowance of \$103.00 per month plus a mileage allowance of 13 cents per mile.

(ii) To public servants holding posts requiring the use of motor-cycles of over 65cc but under 250cc:-

A fixed allowance of \$101.00 per month plus a mileage allowance of 10 cents per mile.

III - AUTO-CYCLE ALLOWANCES

A fixed allowance of \$48.00 per month.

IV – BICYCLE ALLOWANCES

A fixed allowance of \$20.00 per month.

V - FOR OCCASIONAL TRAVELLING BY MOTOR-CYCLES, AUTO-CYCLES AND BICYCLES

An allowance of 23 cents, 13 cents and 8 cents per mile for motor-cycles, auto-cycles and bicycles, respectively.

- 2. Appendix J1 to Civil Service Rules, 1976, is hereby amended accordingly.
- 3. Arrears of travelling allowances payable should be met from voted provision under your control.
