- (iv) School Children.
- (v) Guyana Trades Union Congress.
- (vi) Workers.
- (vii) Guyana State Corporation.

(ix) Guyana Sugar Corporation.

(x) Guyana Mining Enterprise.

5. All contingents would be required to march past the 1763 Monument, where the Vice-President for Works, Cde S.S. Naraine, A.A., M.P., will take the salute.
