The sixth Anniversary Celebrations for the observance of the Cubana Air Disaster in which eleven (11) Guyanese lost their lives will be commemorated on Wednesday, 6th October, 1982, at the 1763 Monument. The starting time of this Rally will be 16:30 hours and the speakers will be the Cde Prime Minister, the Korean and Cuban Ambassadors.

The intention of this circular is to ask that you be good enough to ensure that all staff under your control is aware of this National event and that steps be taken to obtain maximum mobilization in each Ministry and Department. It is therefore expected that official duties on the 6th October, 1982, will end at 15:00 hours and organizations are therefore asked to take into account the starting time of the Rally and the times at which the various parades are schedules to leave their assembly points, as set out below.

ROUTES FOR CUBANA AIR DISASTER RALLY

**TIME OF DEPARTURE
FROM ASSEMBLY POINTS**

1. Camp Ayanganna: Members of the Disciplined Services GDF Military Band and GDP Corps of Drums.
Route: East into Thomas Road, South along Vlissengen Road to the 1763 Monument. 15:45 hours
2. Kitty Market Square: Residents and surrounding schools in Kitty. Steelband(s).
Route: West along Barr Street, south into Vlissengen Road to the 1763 Monument. 15:30 hours
3. Campbellville School: Residents and surrounding schools in Campbellville. YSM Band.
Route: South along Sheriff Street, into Kitty Avenue, west into Homestretch Avenue, south into Vlissengen Road to the 1763 Monument. 15:30 hours
4. NIS Compound: Workers from lower Brickdam (Camp Street to Water Street). Steelband(s).
Route: East along Brickdam to the 1763 Monument. 16:15 hours
5. St. Stanislaus' College: Workers from higher Brickdam (Camp Street to Water Street). Steelband(s).
Route: East along Brickdam to the 1763 Monument. 15:45 hours
6. Dolphin Government School: Workers from Industrial Site and surrounding schools. GDF Corps of Drums.
Route: East along Broad Street, north along Russell Street into Camp Street, east into Brickdam to the 1763 Monument. 15:30 hours

7. East La Penitence Police Station: Residents and surrounding schools. Steelband(s).

Route: West along road in front of East La Penitence Police Station, north into Kitty Avenue, west into 'D' Urban Street, north into Vlissengen Road to the 1763 Monument.

15:30 hours

8. Independence Park: Workers from Water Street, Main Street, Camp Street and Kingston. GNS Ban, Steelband(s).

Route: East into Middle Street, south into Camp Street, east into Regent Street, south into Vlissengen Road to the 1763 Monument.
