- 1) The Theme for Mashramani, 1984 is:-  
“PUT YOUR SPIRIT INTO THE WILL TO SURVIVE.”
- 2) The Sub-Committee responsible for the preparation and organisation of the People’s Parade has decided that as part of the annual Mashramani Celebrations, the People’s Parade will be held on Saturday, February 18 1984 at 7:00 hours.
- 3) You are therefore requested to ensure that adequate steps are taken to facilitate maximum mobilisation and to advise all staff in your Ministry/Department of the necessity for them to participate fully in this event.
- 4) The assembly or pick-up points for this parade are as follows:-
  - i. Camp Ayanganna
  - ii. Kitty Market Square
  - iii. Garnett and Sheriff Streets.
  - iv. D’Urban and John Streets, Lodge.
  - v. Independence Park
  - vi. D’Urban and Smyth Streets, Werk-en-Rust.
  - vii. Bel Air and Sussex Streets.
  - viii. East La Penitence Police Station.
- 5) All contingents would be required to march past the 1763 Monument where the salute will be taken.
- 6) Prizes will be awarded for the best uniformed, best turned out contingents on parade (military, para-military and disciplined organisations would be excluded). You are also asked to ensure that your organisation mounts a suitable banner.
- 7) Please bring the contents of this circular to the attention to all staff within your organisation, so as to ensure maximum participation in this National event.
