Subject to the exigencies of the Public Service, and provided they seek permission in advance, there is no objection to Public Servants being granted time-off on the dates set out below to attend the following forthcoming international cricket matches to be played in Guyana:-

a) Inter-Territorial Shell Shield Series

Guyana vs. Leeward Islands at Albion - Monday 13th and Tuesday 14th February

Guyana vs. Barbados at Bourda - Friday 17th and Monday 20th February

b) Visit of Australian Cricket Team

Guyana vs. Australia at Bourda - Friday the 24th and Monday the 27th February

One day international - West Indies vs. Australia at Albion Wednesday 29th February

First Test match- West Indies vs. Australia At Bourda - Friday the 2nd, Tuesday 6th and Wednesday 7th March.

Permission should be granted only on the clear understanding that extra time is put in so that the work of the Ministries, Departments and Regions does not suffer as a result. Supervisors should therefore be requested to make themselves available to ensure that employees make up the time lost.
