Further to my circular memorandum No. PS: 17/6 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1985 please inform that there is no existing panel of medical practitioner in Canada of which the Guyana high commission could nominate a doctor to render medical assistance to Guyana Public Servants who may fall ill while in Canada. However, theses public servants are still required to observe the procedures set out in the circular No. 4/1972 dated 1972-03-01.

2. The above information is intended for those officers in personnel unit who are responsible for matters relating to leave and who would normally be required to check the names on the panel for verification of medical certificates.
