Category I	-	Best Designed Show –window of local Product.	
Category II	-	Best Decorated School Building	
Category III	-	Best Decorated and Illuminated Building	(Commercial – Large firm)
Category IV	-	Best Decorated and Illuminated Building	(Commercial – Small firm)
Category V	-	Best Decorated and Illuminated Building	(Non-Commercial – Large firm)
Category VI	-	Best Decorated and Illuminated Building	(Non-Commercial – Small firm)

For the purpose of this Competition

- (a) “Commercial Firm” includes all businesses engaged in commerce and trading and which receive direct payment from the Public for goods/services – wholesalers, retailers, insurance companies, cinemas, etc.
- (b) “Non-commercial Firm” includes all Ministries, Government Buildings, Church Buildings and private dwelling houses.

1) Show Windows will be judged as follows:

(a) Originality	100
(b) Theme / relativity	60
(c) Colour and Impact	50
(d) Use and Promotion of Local Materials	40
	250 points

2) Decorated and Illuminated Buildings:

The Building to be judged must be clearly identified on the official entry form with full details. Points will be awarded in the following categories.

Judging will be done during the period 17th – 21st February, 1986 as follows

- 08:00 to 16:00 – for decorations – max. 250 points
- 08:00 to 16:00 – for show-windows – max. 250 points
- 19:00 to 22:00 – for illuminations – max. 250 points

Prizes will be awarded to the winners in each category stated.
