On the occasion of the celebration of our 20th Anniversary of Independence, a number of activities have been planned throughout the country and in Region No. 4 in particular these activities will coincide with youth Week Celebrations and World Solidarity Day.

You are asked to mobilise your staff to attend these functions as specified below:-

1. At 4.30 p.m. on Friday the 23rd May there would be the opening of an Exhibition of the gifts of the late Founder Leader. This exhibition would be held at the Museum and staff in Ministries/Departments in that area are invited to attend the opening function.
2. At 7.00 p.m. on Friday 23rd May, 1986 a Public Rally would be held at the Square of the Revolution. The speaker on this occasion would be the Cde President. A cultural presentation will precede the rally. Staff in all Ministries are invited to attend as a group.
3. At 9.00 a.m. on Saturday 24th of May, 1986 a Photographic Exhibition opens at the Umana Yana. This exhibition highlights our achievements in all fields –cultural, scientific, political –and also give insight of what took place in the pre-independence era. Staff in the Ministries/Departments in that area are invited to attend the opening ceremony.
4. Youth week celebrations commence on Sunday 25th of May, 1986 with a March Past. Youths in the various Ministries are invited to participate in this occasion.
5. At 7.00 p.m. on Sunday 25th May 1986, the Joint services present a Military Tattoo at the National Park. All are invited to participate in this occasion.
6. World Solidarity Day would be commemorated on Monday 26th May, 1986 with a ceremony at 9.00 a.m. at the Liberation Monument. Staff in Ministries/Departments in this area are invited to witness the ceremony.

7. At 8.00 p.m. on Friday 30th May, 1986 a Variety Concert would be held at the National Cultural Centre. Tickets would be on sale at the National Cultural Centre and all are invited to attend.
