Half yearly Travelling Returns of Mileage done by each officer.

It has been observed that Ministries, Departments and Regions are not complying with the instructions given in my circulars no. 1 and 14 of 1969, when submitting their half yearly travelling returns.

"Circular no. 1 of 1969

Reproduced below are relevant extracts of those circulars:-

2. The fixing of mileage ceilings will, with effect from 1st January, 1969, be the responsibility of Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments who are required to submit twice annually to this Ministry, within three weeks of 30th April and 31st October each year, a return showing the ceilings allocated to each post and the monthly mileage covered over the preceding six months by the officers holding these posts. In addition a return showing the ceilings allocated each post should be forwarded to the Accountant General and Director of Audit not later than 15th January each year".

"Circular no. 14 of 1969

.....It has therefore been decided that the required returns should be submitted as in the attached specimen form, a separate return being provided in respect of each of scales 'A', 'B' and 'C''.

3. Please take immediate action to correct the situation by bringing this circular to the attention of the officers who are responsible for compiling and submitting the returns.
