The United Nations has designated the 5th June 1987 as “WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY”, and has urged all his member organizations to undertake such activities to reaffirm their commitment to the preservation and enhancement of their environment.

Guyana as a member of the United Nations has again been requested to participate in the observance of this year's celebrations.

In this regard, your Ministry/Department/Region is asked to organize and undertake a programme of activities during the month of June that will intensify public awareness of environmental problems.

Such a programme may include the following:

- i. Cleaning up, improving (and painting where possible) the interior and exterior of buildings, fences, guard huts, etc.
- ii. Removing unserviceable articles which clutter up offices and compounds of Ministries;
- iii. Repairing tables, desks, cupboards;
- iv. Removing unsightly posters, etc., in buildings and replacing them with new ones;
- v. Repainting, repairing or otherwise rehabilitating sign boards, notice boards;
- vi. Clearing bushes and removing unserviceable vehicles from compounds;
- vii. Replacing old and discoloured flags with new ones.

I shall be grateful if you can submit this Ministry by Friday June 5, 1987, your programme of activities for June 1987.

Your co-operation and support in this exercise will be appreciated.
