SUBJECT:

Payment of Superannuation Benefits to Non-Pensionable
Employees whose service were terminated at 1982-04-01
or thereafter.

Consequent upon a Motion being presented in Parliament on the question of payment of terminal benefits to non-pensionable employees with over one (1) year's service but seven (7), whose services were no longer required with effect from 82-04-01 following the restructuring of the Public Service in 1982, or thereafter, Resolution No. 37 was passed by the national Assembly on 1987-08-07 to facilitate such payment. In this regard, relevant amendments have been embodied in paragraph 2, sections B (ii) and C (ii) of my Circular No. 30/1987 dated 1987-08-27, on the subject "Superannuation Benefits for non-pensionable Government Employees".

2. The Staff of the Personnel Unit/s in your Organisation should therefore proceed with the preparation and submission of relevant documents (i.e. superannuation papers) to the Accountant General in respect of all those employees who qualify for payment in terms of the above Circular, especially those whose services were not required from 1982-04-01, consequent upon the restructuring of the Public Service.
3. Please bring this Circular Memorandum to the attention of the staff in your Organisation, particularly those attached to the Personnel Units.
