**SUBJECT:** World Environment Day –June 5,1988

- 1. The United nations has a designated June 5, 1988 as" WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY" and has urged all its members organizations to undertake such activities to reaffirm their commitment to the preservation and enhancement of the environment
- 2. The team selected by the United Nations Environment Program (UNDEP) Governing Council for 1988 is Public Participation, Environment Protection, and Sustainable Development with special Emphasis on the "Role of Women.
- 3. Guyana as a member of the United Nations has again been requested to participate in the observance of this year's activities.
- 4. In this regard, your Ministry /Department/Region is asked to organize and undertake a programme of activities during the month of June that will promote an increasing public awareness of environmental problem
  - 1. Such a program may include the following
    - i. Cleaning up, improving (and painting where possible) the interior and exterior of buildings fences, guards huts, etc;
    - ii. Preparing suitable banners and posters etc;

- iii. Removing unsightly posters from buildings and replacing them with new ones.
- iv. Repainting, repairing or otherwise rehabilitating sign boards, notice boards;
- v. Clearing bushes and removing unserviceable vehicles from the compound
- vi. Repairing tables, desks and cupboards;
- vii. Replacing old and discoloured flags with new ones.
- 2. This Ministry wishes to express its appreciation of your co-operation and looks forward to your full support.
