1. The Enmore Commemoration Rally will be held on Sunday, 12th June, 1988 at 10:00 hours at the Enmore Monument Square East Coast Demerara. There will also be a Wreath-Laying Ceremony on Thursday, 16th June 1988 at the Repentir Cemetery
  2. It is expected that the attendance at this year's Mass Rally at Enmore would be very High. In order to ensure maximum participation in the Rally, you are requested to assist by mobilizing as many staff members as possible under your control as well as vehicles for transportation of members of staff.
  3. Employees who require transportation to the Rally on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> of June, should assemble at the following places: -
    - 1763 Monument, Vlissengen Road and Homestretch Avenue, between 7:00 hours and 9:15 hours.
    - St. Stanislaus Colledge, Brickdam entrance, between 07:00 and 9:15 hours.

Those attending the Wreath-Laying Ceremony on Thursday June 16<sup>th</sup> are requested to assemble at 7:00 hours at the 1763 monument from where they will move in an orderly procession to the Le Repentir Cemetery. Maximum participation is also expected at this ceremony. In this respect, Heads of Agencies located in the expected vicinity of the Monument (e.g. Office of the President, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Labour and Co-operatives) are requested to encourage their staff to attend
