Subject to the exigencies of the Public Service, and provided they seek permission in advance, there is no objection to Public Servants being granted “time-off” on the dates set out below to attend the forth-coming cricket matches to be played in Guyana: -

- (i) 4th one-day International
West Indies vs. England at Bourda - Wednesday, 7th March
- (ii) 2nd test Match
West Indies vs. England at Bourda - Wednesday, 14th – 15th March

2. Permission should be granted only on the clear understanding that extra time is put in so that the work of Ministries, Departments and Regions does not suffer as a result. Supervisors should therefore be requested to make themselves available to ensure that employees make up the time lost.
