Salary/Wages – Increase for 1990

DATE: 1990-05-14

Government has approved of a seven percent (7%) increase on the level of salaries and wages obtaining at 1989-12-31, with effect from 1990-04-01 for all workers in the Public Service, and in the Public Service related agencies. This Circular therefore authorizes the 7% salaries and wages adjustment in 1990 for all employees in central Ministries, Departments and Regional Administrations (hereinafter called the Public Service) and Public Service related Agencies, the Teaching Service, the Commissions and all other Agencies outside of Guymine, Guysuco and the Public Corporations Group (formerly Guystac).

- 2. In order to compute an employee's adjusted salary/wage with effect from 1990-04-01, calculate 7% of the December 31, 1989 salary/wage level and add the result to the level obtaining at 31st March, 1990. The actual resulting amount must be paid.
- 3. All approved scales within the Public Service and Public Service related agencies have been adjusted by increasing each minimum and maximum by 7% of the respective numbers with effect from 1st April, 1990. Each resulting figure has been rounded to the nearest dollar (please see the appendix overleaf).
- 4. Please note that all those areas and issues not dealt with in this Circular, should be construed in the light of the Ministry's previous salary/wage adjustment circulars, in particular Circulars No.11/1989 dated 7th April, 1989 and No. 20/1989 dated 27th September, 1989.
- 5. Payment of arrears in respect of April and May should be effected from funds under your control as soon as possible after the regular per day for May, 1990.
