Consequently on the adjustment of wages and salaries in the public Service with effect from 15th June, 1990, qualifying salary limit for each leave category mentioned at paragraph 1 of this Ministry's Circular No. 6/1990, dated 24th January 1990, has been adjusted as set out in column 3 below: -

I wish to remind you that when officers proceed on leave during 1991, <u>the adjusted qualifying salary limits</u> set out in column 3 of the schedule must be used to determine leave entitlement and vacation allowance for service given during 1990. I take this opportunity to remind you also that since the introduction of the Merit Awards

Scheme in 1986, Merit Award <u>has not</u>, and <u>should not</u>, be included in an employee's salary in order to determine his placement in the appropriate leave category.

- 3. Please also note that <u>only</u> officers who have been promoted during 1990 and their increased salaries have placed them in a higher category, would qualify for greater leave entitlement during 1991.
- 4. Kindly bring this Circular to the attention of all staff in your Ministries/Departments/Regions, and particularly those in your <u>Personnel and Accounting Divisions</u> who deal with matters relating to the grant of vacation leave and vacation allowances.
