Subject to the exigencies of the Public Service, and provided they seek permission in advance, there is no objection to Public Servants being granted “time-off” on the dates set out below to attend the forthcoming cricket matches to be played in Guyana:-

(i) 5th One Day International - Wednesday, 20th March,
West Indies vs. Australia at 1991
Bourda.

(ii) 2nd Test Match - West Indies - Monday 25th Wednesday
vs. Australia at Bourda: 27th and Thursday 28th
March, 1991.

2. Permission should be granted only on the clear understanding that extra time is put in so that the work of Ministries, Departments and Regions does not suffer as a result. Supervisors should therefore be requested to make themselves available to ensure that employees make up the time lost.
