In accordance with a decision taken at a Special Delegates' Conference of the National Union of Public Service Employees held on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 1990, the amount which should be deducted as Union Dues/Agency Fees from the salaries of Public Servants who fall within the bargaining unit represented by the National Union of Public Service Employees has been increased from fifteen dollars (\$15.00) to twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per month with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 1991.
