Increase in Union Dues / Agency Fees payable to the Guvana Public Service Union.

DATE: 1992-01-03

The General Secretary, Guyana Public Service Union has advised that at a meeting of the General Council held on 17th December, 1991, a decision was taken in accordance with Rule 21 (A) of the Rules of the Union to institute a levy of fifty five dollars (\$55.00) with effect from 1st January, 1992, on each member. As a consequence of this decision, the monthly contribution in respect of Union Dues / Agency fees payable by Public Servants who fall within the bargaining unit represented by the Guyana Public Service Union would be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) with effect from 1st January, 1992.

- 2. The Union has also advised that the increased levy was considered necessary in the light of the following factors/needs:-
 - (i) to generate the sum of \$3.5 million dollars to rehabilitate the Union's Headquarters and its suboffices in New Amsterdam, Berbice and Essequibo;
 - (ii) to finance the holding of educational seminars and workshops in all the Regions during 1992;
 - (iii) to provide increased benefits by approximately 300% (hospitalization, optical, dental and death benefits) through the Benefit Scheme.
- 3. Please bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of all staff in your organization who subscribe to the Guyana Public Service Union, particularly staff of the Accounting / Personnel Divisions / Sections.
