Increase in Union Dues / Agency Fees payable to the
Guyana Public Service Union.

The General Secretary, Guyana Public Service Union has advised that at a meeting of the General Council held on 17th December, 1991, a decision was taken in accordance with Rule 21 (A) of the Rules of the Union to institute a levy of fifty five dollars (\$55.00) with effect from 1st January, 1992, on each member. As a consequence of this decision, the monthly contribution in respect of Union Dues / Agency fees payable by Public Servants who fall within the bargaining unit represented by the Guyana Public Service Union would be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) with effect from 1st January, 1992.

2. The Union has also advised that the increased levy was considered necessary in the light of the following factors/needs:-
 - (i) to generate the sum of \$3.5 million dollars to rehabilitate the Union's Headquarters and its sub-offices in New Amsterdam, Berbice and Essequibo;
 - (ii) to finance the holding of educational seminars and workshops in all the Regions during 1992;
 - (iii) to provide increased benefits by approximately 300% (hospitalization, optical, dental and death benefits) through the Benefit Scheme.
3. Please bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of all staff in your organization who subscribe to the Guyana Public Service Union, particularly staff of the Accounting / Personnel Divisions / Sections.
