The Organising Committee of the Guyana Trade Union Congress has planned a number of activities to commemorate Critchlow Week 1992. Among the events is a May Day Parade around the streets of Georgetown and a Rally at the National Park. The Theme for the May Day Celebrations is “Workers Reward: The Nation’s Gain.”

2. The May Day Parade will take place on Friday May 1, 1992. Participants are requested to assemble at the Independence Park (formerly Parade Ground) at 06:00 hours to move off at 07:00 hours. Workers are requested to march behind their Unions with appropriate banners to identify themselves. The usual wear will be red tops and dark blue / black or white bottoms. The route will be the same as for 1991.
3. The May Day Rally is scheduled for 10:00 hours at the National Park. It will be addressed by Trade Union Leaders including Mr. Carvil Duncan, President, Guyana Trade Union Congress, Mr. Hugh D. Hoyte, S.C., (President General – Guyana Labour Union and President of The Co-operative Republic of Guyana), Dr. Cheddi Jagan (Honourary President – Guyana Agriculture and General Workers Union). Mr. Joseph Pollydore will be the Chairman of the proceedings.
4. Each Region except Region No. 4 will be responsible for organizing its own May Day Celebrations, 1992.
5. Please bring the contents of this circular to the members of staff in your Ministry / Department / Region, and encourage them to participate fully in the events.
