Hoyte, S.C., (President General Guyana Labour Union and President of The Co-operative Republic of Guyana), Dr. Cheddi Jagan (Honourary President Guyana Agriculture and General Workers Union). Mr. Joseph Pollydore will be the Chairman of the proceedings.
- 4. Each Region except Region No. 4 will be responsible for organizing its own May Day Celebrations, 1992.
- 5. Please bring the contents of this circular to the members of staff in your Ministry / Department / Region, and encourage them to participate fully in the events.
