Increase in Union Dues/Agency Fees remitted to the
National Union of Public Service Employees.

In accordance with a decision taken by the Executive Council of the National Union of Public Service Employees (N.U.P.S.E), the amount which should be deducted as Union/Agency Fees from the salaries of Public Servants who fall within the bargaining unit represented by the National Union of Public Service Employees has been increased from sixty dollars (\$60.00) to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month with effect from 1st September, 1994.

2. The Union has advised that the increase was considered necessary in the light of the following circumstances:
 - (i) To offset escalated operational cost to effectively service the membership.
 - (ii) To cater for seminars and educational activities for the membership.
3. Please bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of all staff in your organizations who subscribes to the National Union of Public Service Employees (N.U.P.S.E), particularly staff of the Accounting Division/Personnel Divisions/Sections.
