Increase in Union Dues/Agency fees remitted to the
National Union of public Service Employees

In accordance with a decision taken by the Executive Council of the National Union of Public Service Employees (N.U.P.S.E), the amount which be deducted as Union Dues/Agency Fees from the salaries of Public Servants who fall within the bargaining unit represented by the National Union of Public Service Employees has been increased from one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per month with effect from 1st July, 1995.

2. The Union has advised that the increase was considered necessary in the light of the following circumstances:
 - (i) to offset escalated operational cost to effectively service the membership.
 - (ii) To cater for a new training programme for Shop Stewards and Branch Officials.
3. Please bring this contents of this Circular to the attention of all staff in your organizations who subscribe to the National Union of Public Service Employees (N.U.P.S.E), particularly staff of the Accounting Divisions/Personnel Divisions/Sections.
