Payment of Meal allowance to Nurses and Allied Personnel

I refer to the above subject and now inform you that consequent upon the agreement reached between Government and the Guyana Public Service Union on a final settlement of the retroactive date of payment of Meal Allowance payable to Nurses and Allied Personnel, approval is given for the following: -

- (a) the effective date of payment of Meal Allowance of \$4,000 per month approved in my memorandum No. PS: 20/19^{3III} dated 18th April, 1995, being amended to 1st January, 1994, inclusive, instead of 1st January, 1995, inclusive;
- (b) the effective date of payment of the Hinterland Health Service allowance (Meal Allowance) at the rates of \$8,000 and \$12,000 per month approved at paragraph 1(b) of my Circular Memorandum No. PS: 20/19³ dated 19th January, 1996, being amended to 1st January, 1994, inclusive, instead of 1st January, 1995, inclusive;
- (c) a lump sum payment of \$7,000 (Tax-free) to Nursing Personnel who are eligible for Meal Allowance.
- 2. As regards the deduction from the salary and/or monthly allowance payable to Nursing and other staff who were on strike during March/April, 1996, approval is given for the total sum recoverable to be deducted over a maximum period of six months commencing from May, 1996.
- 3. In order to give effect to Government's undertaking that there would be no break in service of the personnel who were on strike during March/April, 1996, you are requested to provide me by 31st May, 1996, with a comprehensive return in the following format:-
