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Subject to the exigencies of the Public Service which emphasise that official work must be given priority, and provided they seek permission in advance, there is no objection to Public Servants being granted time-off on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> April 1999 to view the One (1) Day International Cricket Match, at Bourda, Georgetown, Guyana, between the West Indies and Australia.

2. Permission should be granted only on the clear understanding that extra time is put in to ensure that the work of Ministries, Departments and Regions does not suffer as a consequence. Supervisors should therefore be requested to make themselves available to ensure that employees make up the lost time.
