Increase in Union Dues/Agency Fees – Union of  
Agricultural and Allied Workers

I wish to inform you that the General Secretary of the Union of Agricultural and Allied Workers has advised that the Executive Council of the Union has taken a decision to increase the Union Dues/Agency Fees from three hundred dollars (\$300) per month to four hundred dollars (\$400) per month for monthly paid employees and from seventy-five (\$75) per week to one hundred dollars (\$100) per week, non-monthly paid employees with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2000.

3. I have been asked to convey this decision to you, as I now do, with a view to the deductions being made from salaries of those categories of officers who fall within the bargaining unit of the abovementioned Union.
5. Employees who subsequently object to the increase being deducted from salaries should be required to record their objections, in writing, to their Accounting Officers.
6. Please bring this Circular to the attention of all staff within your organization who subscribe to the Union of Agricultural and Allied Workers particularly staff in your Accounting and Personnel Divisions/sections having regard to the terms and conditions at paragraphs 1 and 3 above.
