The United Nations, through its resolution A/65/PV.34 has designated the first week in February of every year as World Interfaith Harmony Week and Member States have been asked to commemorate this week with activities that promote religious harmony.

A committee was formed to prepare a programme for the observance of World Interfaith Week in Guyana. As part of its activities planned, is a "Harmony Walk" which is scheduled to take place on Thursday February 3rd, 2011. This walk will start at 11:30hrs from the Bank of Guyana and will lead to the Promenade Gardens for the Display of a Cultural Presentation.

In view of the above, approval has been given for Public Servants who are desirous of participating in the march to be released from 1030hrs to 1300hrs on February 3, 2011.

The Committee has also proposed that Public Servants wear gold T-shirts, ribbons and other clothing, the colour designated as a sign of peace and harmony, during the week January 31 to February 5, 2011 and particular on the march on February 3, 2011.
